

Te Whakakitenga o Waikato Incorporated (“we” or “us”)

SPORTS GRANT

To promote and foster healthy and active tribal members, the Sports Grant is made available to registered tribal members who are individual athletes and/or sports administrators. Sports teams and/or clubs that have a strong affiliation to Waikato-Tainui and its Marae are also eligible to apply. Eligible applicants of the Sports Grant include:

- Individual athletes or administrators who are registered tribal members residing in New Zealand. An administrator refers to a coach, manager, referee or umpire only.
- Teams, clubs or regional associations whose membership consists of a minimum of 50% of tribal members are also eligible to apply.
- Waikato-Tainui Raupatu Marae or clusters of Waikato-Tainui Raupatu Marae for sporting activities or initiatives.

Other information is as follows.

- Applications are considered by the Sports Grant Advisory monthly, for funds that are to be used in the future. No grants will be given retrospectively.
- Applicants may receive up to two grants per financial year (1 April – 31 March) for one sport code only.
- Expenses that will not be covered under the Sports Grant include personal equipment or training items for individuals and costs associated with after match functions or social gatherings.
- An application must be completed in full and must include a budget for the relevant expenses. Budgets that include travel, accommodation, uniforms or equipment must be supported by two formal quotes, unless costs have been set by a regional or national body (in which case please supply evidence of this).
- Decisions about application outcomes are final and no correspondence will be entered into. If approved, grants will be paid into the applicant’s nominated bank account on or around the 20th of the following month.
- Successful applicants may be asked to participate in Waikato-Tainui tribal events or promotional purposes as role models for healthy and active living.
- Sole discretion as to whether we accept or decline an application rests with us.
