This year we are using the Games to promote kaupapa that are good for us. We are working towards health and wellbeing for our whaanau, hapuu, and iwi - mauri ora!

Kai pai (Healthy food), auahi kore (smoke free), waipiro kore (alcohol free), tarutaru kore (drug free), and para kore are all kaupapa we are promoting. As Maaori we introduce ourselves with our pepeha, our maunga, our awa, our hapuu, our iwi. How we run events has a direct impact on the health of our people, our maunga and awa. Prevention and minimisation of waste at events is about whakapapa. Healthy kai and auahi kore is about whakapapa. We are using this opportunity to provide education to our people about how we can live in more sustainable ways with better health.

Please read on for more information about what's required to run a stall at the Tainui Games.

By submitting this application for consideration, you support the promotion of healthy kai, no single use plastic packaging and all other kaupapa we are promoting at the 2023 Tainui Games.

You agree to the sale of healthy kai and no single use plastic packaging. You also agree to reduce the sale of unhealthy kai and the use of single use plastic packaging at our event. Unhealthy kai includes deep fried food, foods high in saturated fat, foods high in sugar including all fizzy/energy drinks, and foods high in salt.
