The Oranga Marae Committee mainly wants to see that whānau have worked together to plan for the sustainable future of their marae, and that the hapū will support the plan to make it happen.

This is what we want to do for our marae

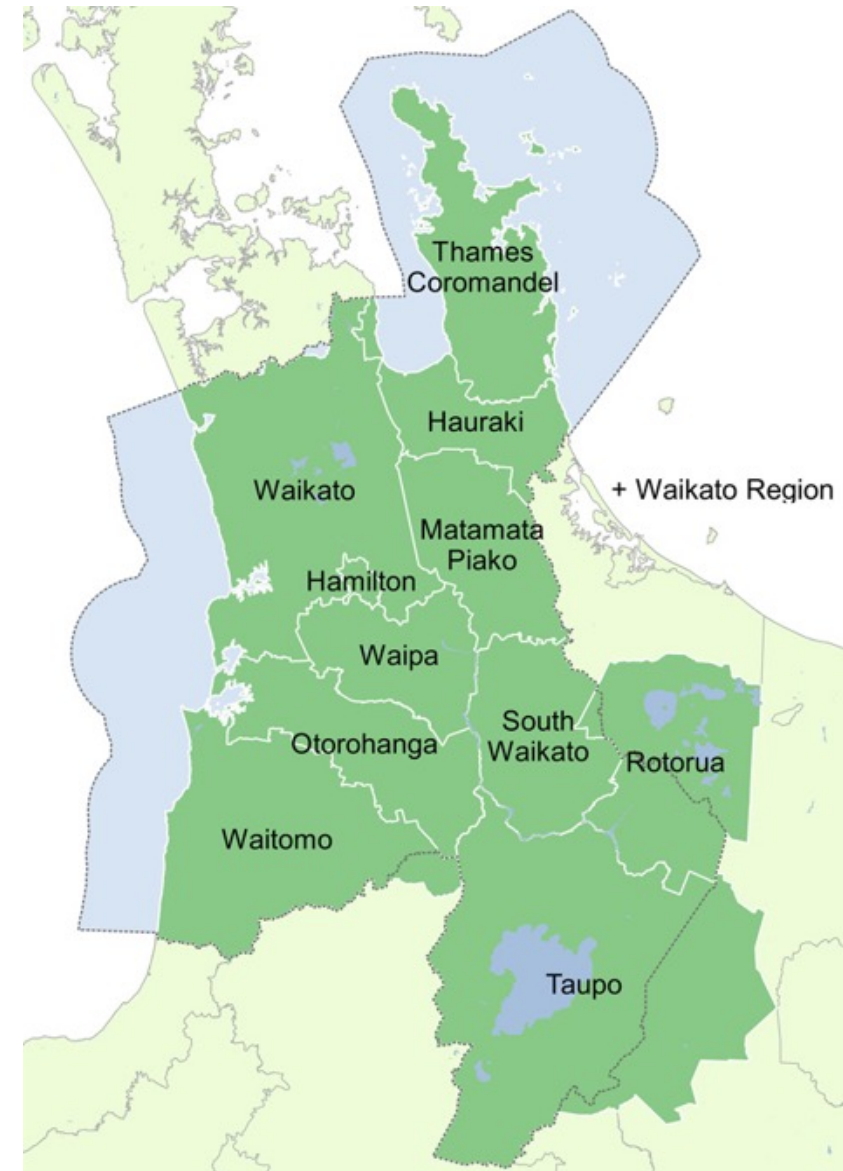
Some examples:

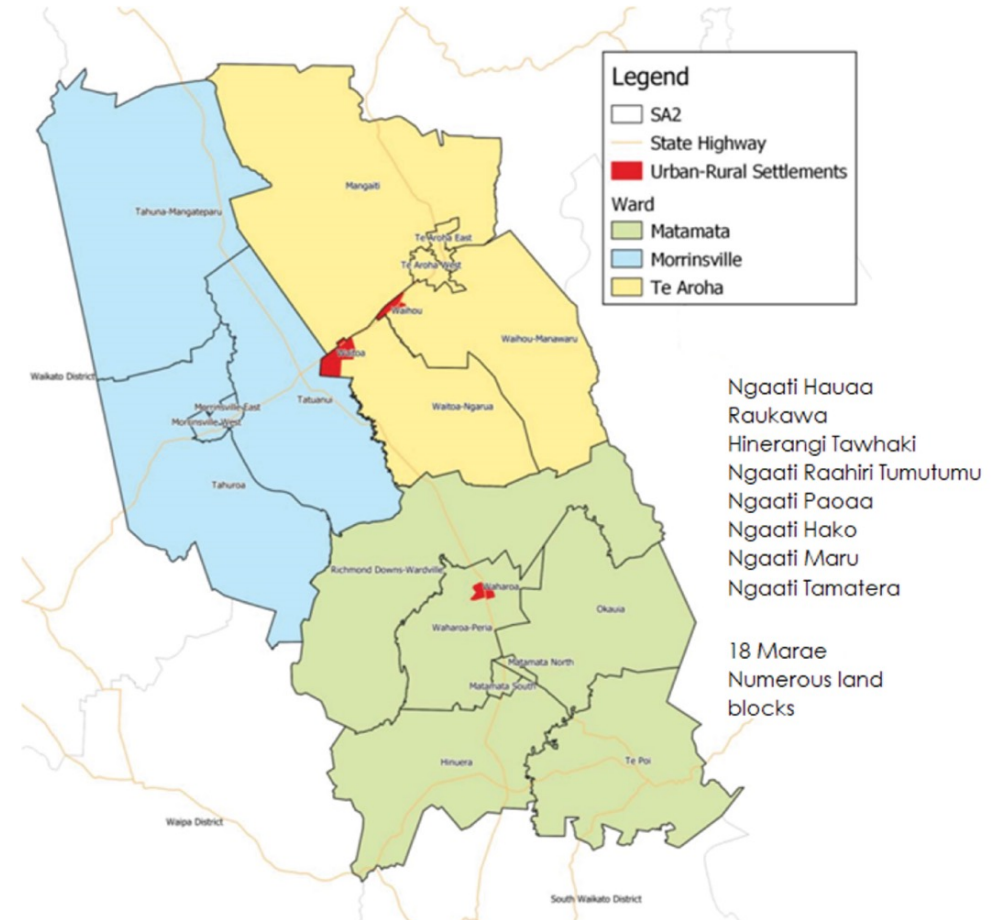
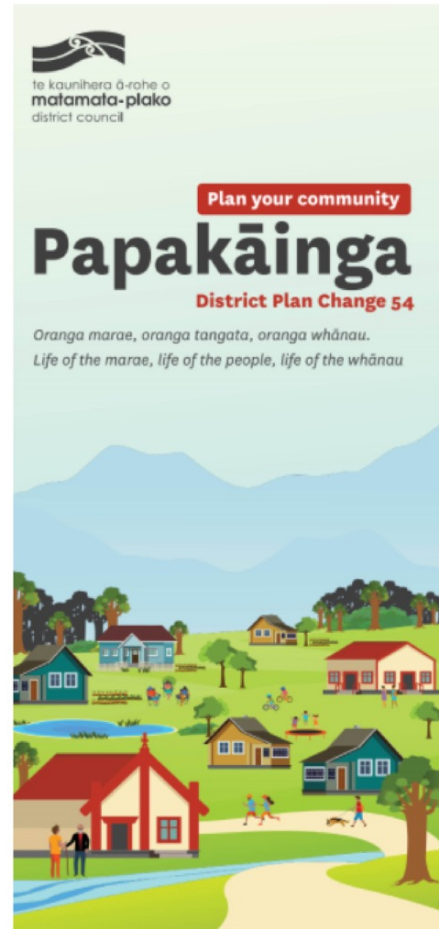
- For the marae to flourish families must be able to come home to live, work, play, raise their children, to fulfil the roles of the marae, and to bury their loved ones
