

Taurahere Strategy 2024 - 2029

Purpose: Taura Here (binding ropes) is a term used to describe tribal members who reside outside their tribal areas. This strategy will help members to retain their identity and links back to their tribal homelands.



Theme 1: Hononga – Connectedness: Tribal members can remain connected to Kiingitanga, Marae and iwi activities.



Theme 2: Waananga – Participation and Learning: Tribal members have access to learning and participation opportunities.



Theme 3: Tautoko – Support: Tribal members will have access to support from Waikato- Tainui.
