

Paa Whakawairua Grant Application

Te Whakakitenga o Waikato Incorporated ("we" or "us" "Waikato-Tainui")

The Waikato-Tainui Paa Whakawairua Grant is specifically designed for Waikato-Tainui Raupatu Marae and is aimed at facilitating Oranga Marae developments. The grant provides co-funding for initiatives including Marae Development Plans, Feasibility Studies, and Major Capital Works, with the primary objective of supporting the enhancement, sustainability, and long-term resilience of Marae infrastructure.

Terms and Conditions

Applicant

- Application is on behalf of one of our 68 Waikato-Tainui Raupatu Marae
- Applicant is a Marae Trustee or Marae Committee Member
- Completed application form in full

Supporting Documents

- Full details of the project including expected outcomes, dates and budget.
- Reta Tautoko - Endorsement from Marae
- For Feasibility Study/Plan or Capital Works Project, a Marae Development Plan is required.
- Confirmation or conditional external funding if any.
- Marae or Trust Bank Confirmation (must contain bank logo, account name and number)

Marae is eligible to receive funding for **ONE** Marae Development Plan (or Strategic Plan), **ONE** Feasibility Study, and **ONE** Capital Works project within a three financial year period.

This provision ensures equitable access to funding and supports a staged and sustainable approach to Marae development.

Sole discretion to accept, withdraw or defer a grant application that does not meet criteria rests with us. Decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Incomplete applications will be withdrawn after 60 days and a new application form needs to be completed.


Grant Application Process

Marae Development Plan | Marae Strategic Plan

These applications are processed via an invoice paid direct to the Marae or to an external Partner who is helping to facilitate the plan. Once approved our team will provide you with a Purchase Order Number, please include this on your invoice along with the following information, Invoice Number, Invoice Date, Your GST Number (if GST Registered), Net Amount, GST Amount, (if GST Registered) and Total Amount.

***Please Note:**

- **Invoices are paid on the 20th of the month, following the invoice date.**
- *If the Partner you have selected to assist your Marae is not a registered vendor this may disrupt processing times and can cause delays. As we will need to onboard them as a vendor.*




Feasibility Study | Plan and Capital Works

Opens 1st April 2026 Closes 24th July 2026

All applications received during this time will be assessed, with applicants notified of an outcome by the first week of September 2026.

If approved by Te Aratua in August, payment is due on the 21st of September 2026.

This is a long-term, high-value endeavor designed to improve, add to, or build upon existing property, plant, or equipment. Capital projects can involve significant expenditures compared to other projects and require considerable resources.
