

Sports Grant (Organisation or Club) Application

Te Whakakitenga o Waikato Incorporated ("we" or "us" "Waikato-Tainui")

The Waikato-Tainui Sports Grant is open for applications from organisations whose membership consists of at least 75% tribal members, with the aim of promoting and enabling healthy and active tribal communities. It is open to organisations with a strong affiliation to Waikato-Tainui and its marae, who align with Whakatupuranga 2050, Kiingitanga, and the vision of maximising our collective strengths and achieving our aspirations.

*Expenses that will not be covered under the Sports Grant include personal equipment or training items for individuals and costs associated with after match functions or social gatherings towards your Tournament.

Terms and Conditions

Organisation or Club Applicant

- Person applying on behalf of Organisation or Club must be a registered Waikato-Tainui tribal member
- Person applying on behalf of Organisation or Club must have Identification on file (Birth Certificate, Drivers Licence or Passport)
- Organisation or Club must **75%** registered Waikato-Tainui tribal members
- Completed application form in full

Supporting Documents

- Confirmation of selection letter
- Organisation or Club Bank Confirmation (must contain bank logo, account name and number)
- Confirmation of **75%** registered Waikato-Tainui tribal members

Only **ONE** grant application is available per organisation.

Sole discretion to accept, withdraw or defer a grant application that does not meet criteria rests with us. Decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Incomplete applications will be withdrawn after 60 days and a new application form needs to be completed.


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Grant Application Process

These applications will be assessed as per our usual Sports Grant process. Most grant application payments take up to eight weeks for processing, approval and payment. If approved payment is due on the **21st** of the month following approval.

**Example- If an application has been approved by Te Arataura in April, applicants will receive payment on the 21st of May*



Other statuses you may see are:

WITHDRAWN - The application does not meet criteria or is a duplicate application.

DEFERRED - The application requires more information or has been deferred until a later date, in which case the approval process will take longer than 8 weeks.
