VISION

Mokopuna thriving in safe, nurturing whaanau environments, empowered by their whakapapa.

MISSION

To establish a Waikato-led, mokopuna-focused care and protection model that is whaanau-informed, hapori supported, and grounded in mana motuhake, enabling all mokopuna to thrive.

WHO ARE WE?

Te Whakakitenga o Waikato Incorporated Society is the tribal parliament representing Waikato-Tainui statutory rights and interests. They ensure the benefit of the settlement grows for the future generations. Whakatupuranga 2050 is the long-term strategic plan of Waikato-Tainui setting the outcomes framework that Mokopuna Ora seeks to advance. Te Arataura is the executive committee of Te Whakakitenga overseeing the day-to-day activities of the tribe.

After signing a high-level Memorandum of Understanding in 2013, Waikato-Tainui and Oranga Tamariki (formerly CYFS) entered a strategic partnership in 2015. This collaboration was guided by the Tribe's belief that working together would achieve better results for mokopuna and whaanau, particularly in addressing the overrepresentation of iwi Maaori mokopuna in care.

Mokopuna Ora is a kaupapa Maaori strengths-based and whaanau-led model of care. We work to ensure whaanau and hapuu can be actively involved in decision-making on how their mokopuna can remain safely in their care. While reducing the number of Waikato iwi mokopuna entering and remaining in the care and protection system. In situations where mokopuna are unable to be cared for by their whaanau, hapuu, or iwi, we support their connection to their whakapapa and cultural identity.

Mokopuna Ora front line kaimahi are domiciled in Oranga Tamariki offices where there are the highest number of Waikato iwi mokopuna involved with Oranga Tamariki. Mokopuna Ora front line work extends to include any whaanau Maaori who are based in these geographical areas; triaging those most at risk.

Mokopuna Ora also has a wider strategic focus on systemic change and indigenising Aotearoa's Care and Protection system. The work of our frontline operations provides real-time experience and whaanau voice that is influential to our strategy and design.

Mokopuna Ora is at a watershed moment, Oranga Tamariki is seeking to devolve its statutory functions to the community. In response we are entering a period of discovery, feasibility and design where we will focus on developing our own indigenous care and protection model.

Values	Reflected in the following behaviours:
Aroha (Love/Respect)	Develops strong ties and respect across Waikato by showing high levels of integrity and upholding the mana of our history. Puts others at ease, understanding their needs and communicating ideas in an effective manner to continually 'do the right thing'
Whakaiti (Humility)	Respects the views of others, including the wider iwi through asking for, listening to and considering the views of those they interact with so that we learn from our past to better shape our future. Prioritises the kaupapa by not putting themselves or their opinions ahead of others
Kotahitanga (Unity)	Recognises and respects our diversity and the strength this creates by demonstrating awareness and sensitivities of others. Is part of the solution by creating the right environment that helps us to act in unified fashion
Whakaponu (Trust/Faith)	Strong Kiingitanga affiliation demonstrated by their knowledge/ skills positively, treating colleagues, clients and the public with courtesy, sensitivity and integrity to build trust
Manaakitanga (Caring)	Supports others through constructive, positive behaviours and productive and positive two-way communications so that we help each other to succeed and as a result enhance the achievements of the tribe
Mahitahi (Collaboration)	Demonstrates a willingness to work together and empower others to collaborate while being open to new ideas and perspectives. Helps to create a change resilient, outcomes focused, culture of excellence
Rangimarie (Peace/Calm)	Comfortable with ourselves while also being open to feedback, guidance and support from others. Projects a calm, open-minded and reasoned manner when dealing with the demands put on us and the challenge this may create



PRIMARY FOCUS OF THIS ROLE – TE AROTAHI MAATUA

The Senior Business Analyst is a strategic system-level role responsible for shaping, analysing, and advancing the Waikato-Tainui Mokopuna Ora business strategy and outcomes framework, in alignment with Te Whakatupuranga 2050.

This role goes beyond project analysis—it leads system intelligence, strategic planning, insights generation, and improvement initiatives that influence organisational direction and sector-wide practices. The Senior Business Analyst provides high-level insights and advice, enables decision-making across Mokopuna Ora and the wider organisation, and strengthens Mokopuna Ora’s role as a system leader within iwi, Maaori, and Crown landscapes.

The role stewards intelligence, relationships, and processes that ensure Mokopuna Ora is operating proactively, strategically, and with long-term system impact. Additionally, this role will take a mentoring approach for our Business and Data Analysts, and in bringing the wider Mokopuna Ora team along the journey.

The Senior Business Analyst serves as the expert in their field and is responsible for identifying and raising any risks, issues, blockages, or concerns with the Principal Advisor. Upon surfacing these matters, the Senior Business Analyst and the Principal Advisor collaboratively discuss and explore possible solutions to determine the best way forward, ensuring informed decision making and effective prioritisation.
